



Powersville Recycling Convenience Center

Anderson County constructed the Dolly M. Cooper Park in Powersville located in northeastern Anderson County. The initial phase of the project included the main entrance to the park off Old Anderson Highway and a manned recycling convenience center. Design South provided final design, permitting, bidding and construction administration services.

Scope:

- 13,500 cubic yards of earthwork
- 2,200 square yards of asphalt pavement and 1,500 linear feet of concrete curb and gutter at site entrance roadway
- 700 square yards of asphalt pavement, 750 square yards of concrete pavement, and 600 linear feet of concrete curb and gutter at Recycling Center site
- Incidental storm drainage, utilities, fencing and landscaping
